



Glogster – Teacher Tutorial

Glogster is a multi-media presentation tool that allows students to use pictures, videos, text, audio and built-in graphics and other tools to create the 21st-century equivalent of a poster. These posters are interactive – viewers can play audio and video files, view images in different sizes, scroll through text boxes to read large amounts of text – and can be viewed individually or imbedded into webpages and shared.

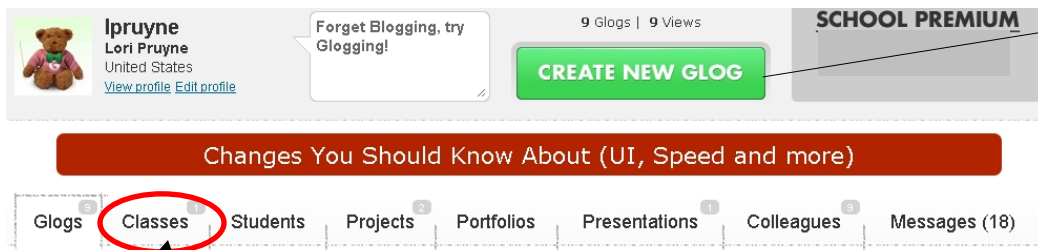
Logging in to Glogster:

1. Go to <http://edu.glogster.com> **NOTE - There is a plain Glogster, for the general public, and GlogsterEdu, which is for schools and students. Be sure you're at the right site!
2. Sign in as an educator in order to access the premium features that come with the district subscription. Use the log-in information provided by your librarian.



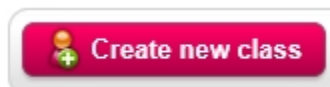
Creating Classes and Adding Students:

1. When you log in, you will be brought to the “**My Dashboard**” screen. You will return to this screen whenever you want to start something new, such as create a new glog, new class, new project, manage student accounts, and more



Click the “**Classes**” tab to create a class. You can add all students to one class, or create separate classes for each group.

2. Click on the pink “**Create new class**” button, then fill in the pertinent information about the class (You do not need to upload a picture icon) and press save.

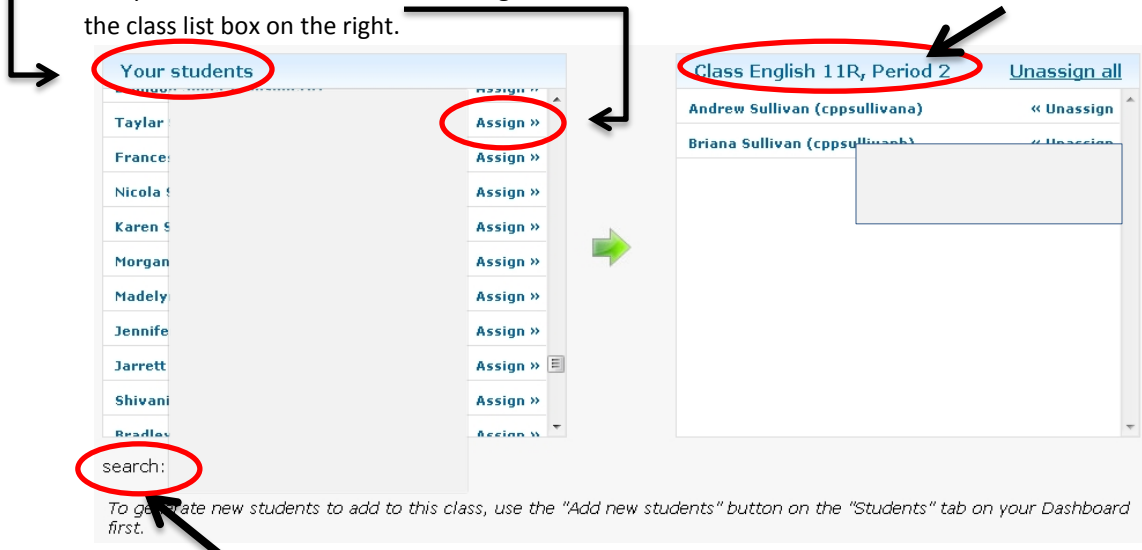


- Once you have created your classes, you will want to add students. Creating a new class will bring you right to the class page – you can also access all classes through the “Classes” tab on your dashboard.

Once you have selected a page, click the pink “Add students here” button. This will bring up a box labeled “Your students,” which is



comprised of an alphabetical (by last name) list of all students in the school. Simply scroll down the list to find your students, click the blue “Assign” tab next to each student’s name, and he/she will be moved to the class list box on the right.



You can also use the “search” box to look for individual students. If a student does not have an account, see your librarian to have them added to Glogster.

“Messages” allows you to send email-type messages to students or other users through your Glogster accounts
