While Smore was designed to help promote events, it's also a very effective presentation tool that is free and easy to use!


Go to <u>http://www.smore.com</u> and click the sign-up link. Fill in the information requested to create a smore account.

Use the editing menu on the right to change the style, template, fonts and more.



That title menu allows you to change the background image for the smore, the colors, the fonts, etc.

Along the bottom of the smore, you will find buttons for different types of content – text, pictures, video, audio and more! Just click on the button. Once you've filled in the content, you can drag it up or down to rearrange the order of information in your Smore. Add as much as you need!



The different buttons allow you to share your Smore in different ways. You can send emails notifying students/parents/community members about the Smore (free accounts are limited to 1,000 a month), and you can share it via various social media accounts. Click the gray button in the share menu that says "Embed" to generate a code that that allows you to put a Smore right into a page (like a Weebly or Edmodo). This button also gives you the URL of the Smore that you can give directly to people to connect to the Smore.
